

INSTALL INSTRUCTIONS

- Install Android device into HDMI port on the TV. We would like to be in HDMI1 if possible because it is the first go-to source with most TV brands. Use the small HDMI cable extension to avoid difficulty plugging Android device into HDMI port as the position of the port may be troublesome.
- Hopefully your TV has a 5-amp USB port to power the device. We like this because when the TV is turned off the power source for the stick is turned off. This forces the device to reboot each time the TV is turned on/off. If a 5-amp USB port is not available you will need a block to plug the USB end of the power cord into and then into a 110 outlet. If you plug into a USB port on the TV that is less than 5 amp (2.5 amp as an example) the device will go through its boot up process continually displaying the device mfg. name and repeating over and over. Please install device in such a way that it is easy to access for a physical reboot and to see if it is displaying a red light meaning the device is turned off or the green light meaning the device is turned on.
- Put the TV source/input on the corresponding HDMI port (HDMI1 for example). After the Android stick boots up you will see a screen with many thumbnail options. Choose the ADN thumbnail and this will take you directly to the dealership home screen.
- Select the setting button on the remote. This is the button that has the image of a gear. Go to the WIFI settings and select the strongest access point available/approved for our device. We can not use a guest WIFI that requires an "agreement of terms selection" as this function requires a mouse. We must have a strong access point! If our device is on a weak AP, it will not operate smoothly and the screens will freeze. Our device only uses about 5-8 Mbps but requires smooth transmission and headroom. Therefore, the best option is the strongest AP. Once connected hit the HOME button on the remote then select the ADN option and you will be taken to the dealership home screen. From here refer to the video referenced above in the top right-hand corner of our website "click here for an operation guide". It is recommended that this video is viewed prior to installation.
- For operational instructions on navigating the home screen options please go to our website www.AutoDealerNetwork.TV (please have a few people familiarize themselves with this operation process). In the upper right-hand corner of the home screen there is a navigation button that says "Click here for an operations guide". This is a full tutorial for the use of ADNTV.
